

I. PURPOSE:

Environmental Objectives and Targets are developed in response to the policy and aspects analysis. In those cases where an objective or target is developed for an aspect, it will be consistent with the policy regarding prevention of pollution and continuous improvement, considering legal and other requirements, technological options, financial, operational and business requirements, and the views of interested stakeholders.

II. SCOPE:

The following describes the procedures for setting Objectives and Targets associated with the manufacturing operation.

IV. PROCEDURE:

1. Develops objectives and targets for recommendation to management in terms of environmental issues. Criteria considered on developing the objectives and targets include:
 - a. Liability exposure
 - b. Regulatory requirements (present and pending)
 - c. Cost
 - d. Significant environmental aspects and impacts
 - e. Prevention of pollution
 - f. Technological Options
 - g. Views of Interested Parties by review of External Communication logs.

NOTE: The development of objectives and targets is completed in conjunction with the preparation of the Environmental Management Plan, Management Review and the budget process.

2. Prepares the Environmental Management Plan, along with related necessary resources. The Environmental Management Plan is presented to the Management Review meeting for subsequent review and approval.
3. The Environmental Management Plan document, once approved by the appropriate managers named above, is signed and becomes the record of this procedure.

NOTE: The signature list at the end of this procedure indicates approval of the Objectives and Targets.
